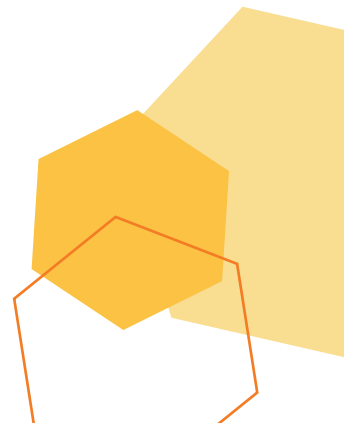
Any workplace where workers interact with electrical systems or equipment:
